YOU'RE TOUCHING LIVES WITH FOOD AND SO MUCH MORE

Did you know that some individuals in your community are missing 5.3 meals a week? These are neighbors like the family pictured above. We can see a nice smiling photo, but what we can't see are the empty stomachs or the worries of not knowing where their next meal will come from. In fact, in the year ahead, people across Southern Nevada who are food insecure will miss thousands of meals.

The reasons behind the missed meals are many. Some of these folks have lost their jobs. Some are on a very fixed income and are having to choose between food and rent or electricity. In the early weeks of the COVID shutdown, the number of calls received through the Three Square Center skyrocketed to more than 7,000 in just two days. Although we have seen a downward trend in the number of individuals in need, food insecurity in Southern Nevada remains higher than what we saw pre-pandemic, and the call center continues to receive about 2,000 calls per month. Now, nearly 460,000 Nevadans are reeling from reduced SNAP

benefits, even as grocery costs soar.

2020: The Just One Project —


Serving more than 20,000 Southern Nevadans each month, TJOP embodies compassion and collaboration.


2021: International Church of Las Vegas — ICLV rescues food from 16 stores every week and is known for innovation and stewardship.

2022: City Impact Center —


City Impact is known for unparalleled dedication to urgency and transparency, expanding service to help ever more families in crisis.
